

MOTION FOR EXTENSION



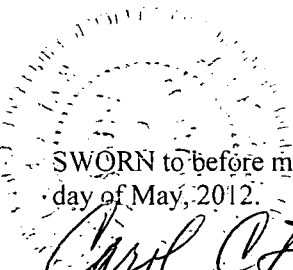
