1. The nexus of this present motion, asserts that during the pendency of this (appeal for denial of relief from 2013 / SCC Ann. 44-48-110 Annual Review of Feb. 2013) Another 44-48-110 Annual Review Hearing was conducted for 2015

a) The 2015 44-48-110 review was denied.

b) Respondant Deans, filed a Rule 59 SCRCR, motion to which, the lower Court dismissed / closed the case no: 2002-CP-04-3343.

Appellant then filed this motion for an order consistent with the order dismissing the case, in the lower Court.

c) The State came back with it's Return claiming the case is not dismissed but only dismissing the (annual review).

d) Appellant filed a Reply by Ref: on Dec. 1, 2015 in this Court containing Exhibits A-G, which Appellant now supports with the following Exhibits H-I.

2. To confuse matters beyond obsurdity, On Jan. 21, 2016 the SCDMH SVPTP Director filed the (2016) Notice / Annual Review / 2016 Examination Report,

a) The State then filed a Motion To Deny Annual Review, on 2/10/16.

b) Deans filed a Return and ~~was~~ this was refused to be filed by the Clerk of Court, 10th Judicial Circuit, because Deans had been dismissed and case closed. see hereto, Appellants Exhibit H

c) The State filed a purposed order on 2/18/16, denying 44-48-110 Annual Review.

d) Deans made a Reply to the purposed order, to which the Clerk of Court, again refused to file.

3. Appellants does not in any manner argue or appeal the denial of 2016 Annual

Review, it's the fact of being a dismissed case in which Deans can not even appeal because he has been dismissed is why Appellant is before the Court now asking for relief.

5. How or why the Clerk of Court, 10th Judicial Circuit even filed the 2016 Notice of Annual Review, and the States Return and Purposed Order is beyond legal comprehension / this for another day. but not here.
  - a) This is the exact same thing that happened to which lead to Appellants false civil committment, being the 10th / clerk of Court allowed a defacto Order to with draw of Nov. 12, 2002, a Order Dismissing the case on Oct. 31, 02.
6. See Appellants Exhibit H, dated Feb. 8, 2016 Clerk of Court / 10th Judicial Circuit is confused as to what a dismissed case does not allow any filings to enclude a SCC Ann 44-48-110 Annual Review, the reasoning is how can you have a Annual Review against a (Deans) who has been dismissed from the case.
  - a) Then See Appellants Exhibit I, the same Clerk of Court / 10th Judicial Circuit states un-equivently, under no circumstance can Deans file any documents in 2002-CP-04-3343.
7. This in turns documents Deans is still being held incarcerated under an expired criminal conviction, that legally ended on Aug. 24, 2003, for there is no lawfull order of civil committed having been barred by the limitations of Rule 58 (a)(2), and Rule 59 (d) SCRPC. supported with 100's of SC Supreme Courts cases barring any actions past the ten day limit.
