Even if the negotiations were fair and honest they still should not be used as a basis to compel the Appellant to settle against her will.





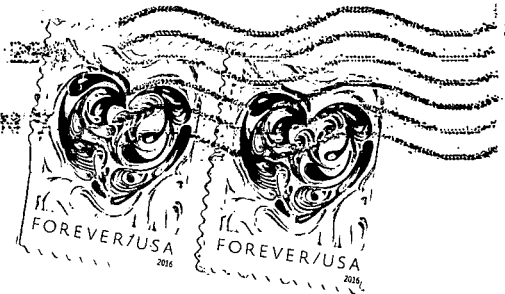
