This is my second Complaint regarding this case. The Constitution ensures equal protection of the law, regardless to respect to persons. Lady Justice is blindfolded for this reason.

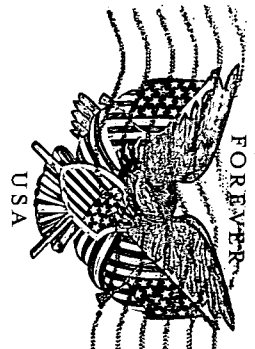
The mettle that it takes to look away from the legal errors presented, has culminated into the practiced habit of jabbing out one's eyes and forgetting the work of one's hand.

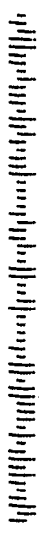
