I have some concerns about the process which will be express in this letter. I used the forms format as it was located on from SC Judicial Center Web Page to avoid any mistakes. I knew that appellant should be before respondent but your form format has the other way which was followed. I had to resubmit forms again which required more money, resources and time. I filed a notice of appeal with SC Court of Appeals and Richland County Court of Common Pleas and somehow the information was misplaced. I had to resubmit notice of appeal again which required more money, resources and time. Richland County Court of Common Pleas currently shows two notice of appeal which is verification of the refileing. I filed my initial brief with In Forma Pauperis which was finally denied January, 2016 by SC Court of Appeals. I was denied due to having no income since January, 2015 providing information as a currently recipient of foodstamps therefore required to pay \$100.00 court fee. I was recently informed that \$25.00 is needed for court to entertain motion to proceed without transcrip which is not needed at this time since transcript has been received. I was told that transcript was needed even though a motion was submitted to process initial brief without it. I filed a notice of ordering transcript when submitting initial brief but received notification from you that information had not been completed which was corrected by SC Court of Appeals after verification was provided which required more money, resources and time. The problems with transcript has already been expressed and properly documented. I received the transcript even though not completely satisfied and provided copies to SC Court of Appeals, SC Administration (SCBC), South Carolina Department of Employment Workforce, Office of South Carolina Governor Office and Attorney, Eugene Matthews I submitted the transcript as is indicated on case#2015-002356 profile that was missing.

I have been told that initial brief, transcript and other information for process must be resubmitted to SC Court of Appeal, SC Administration (SCBC), South Carolina Department of Employment Workforce, Office of South Carolina Governor and Atty. Eugene Matthews which will required more money, resources and time. I may have not done some things completely accurate but there seems to be too many problems. I was dedicated to following the instructions from SC Judicial Center as a guide. I do not know exactly the problems but it seems as a possible delay.

I will continued to fulfill the obligations of SC Court of Appeals to have this case received the proper justice required under the law and appreciate your assistance thus far.

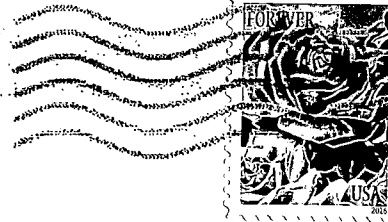
