LABORATORY FINDINGS: Urine Drug Screen was positive for marijuana. SMA 24 showed phos. 5 mg/dl. Thyroid Profile was within normal limits. CBC with differential was unremarkable. RPR was non-reactive. Urinalysis was ordered but the results were not in the chart at the time of dictation. Mr. English has no known allergies. PPD was negative.

HOSPITAL COURSE & TREATMENT: Mr. English was admitted to Lodge D. In addition to standing orders, his treatment was with Haldol 5 mg. p.o. b.i.d. and Cogentin 1 mg. p.o. b.i.d. Mr. English took only one dose of both of these and refused the second dose; they were then discontinued. He was also given Vistaril 25 mg. p.o. t.i.d. On admission to the lodge, he told the admitting nurse that he went to Richland Memorial Hospital because he thought "food poisoned" him and Richland Memorial Hospital sent him to BPH. He said he did not believe that he needed to be at BPH. During his hospitalization, he attended the patient education substance abuse group, medication teaching group, health style, and anger management group. He also received individual therapy. While he got along adequately with other people on a general basis, there was once insistence in which he made verbal threats towards another patient resulting him being moved to another bed. At the time of his discharge, he was without signs of suspiciousness and denied suicidal or homicidal ideations. Mr. English was discharged per verbal order of the probate court.

CONDITION ON DISCHARGE: Anxiety improved, delusions improved, no suicidal or homicidal ideations.

DISCHARGE MEDICATIONS: Vistaril 25 mg. p.o. t.i.d.

DISPOSITION: The patient will return to live with his mother.
