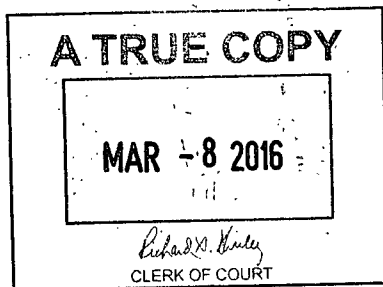


This matter is before the Court pursuant to the Plaintiff's Motion for Reconsideration. The Court granted the Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment on August 10, 2015. The Plaintiff filed a Motion for Reconsideration on August 17, 2015. The Plaintiff filed the motion with the Clerk of Court of Anderson County, but did not serve the Judge with a copy of the motion, making the Judge unaware that there was a pending motion in the case. The Clerk of Court did not set the matter for a hearing because the Plaintiff filed an appeal on August 20, 2015. The Plaintiff did not withdraw or dismiss her Motion for Reconsideration when filing the appeal. The Plaintiff's appeal was dismissed by the South Carolina Court of Appeals on August 26, 2015, on the grounds that there was a pending motion. The Plaintiff filed a second notice of appeal on October 26, 2015 which again the Court of Appeals dismissed because of the pending motion. The Plaintiff still has not sent a copy of her motion to the Judge, as required by SCRCR Rule 59(g). The Plaintiff also has not requested a hearing on the matter. However, upon notice that there was a pending motion, the Court directed the Clerk of Court to forward the Plaintiff's motion to him and received a copy on March 4, 2016.

After careful consideration of the materials presented, I find that there is no new evidence or law presented which would warrant this Court's Order being modified. Therefore, the Plaintiff's Motion for Reconsideration is denied.
