
I am writing this letter briefly in response to the motions filed by Mr. McDaniel on behalf of Mr. Winfrey related to medical care issues.

As the court previously set out, the issues raised by Mr. McDaniel are for the Workers' Compensation Commission. There is a question over whether care requested by Mr. Winfrey is causally related to the heart condition previously awarded by the Commission. That is a decision solely for the Workers' Compensation Commission. As the defendants in this matter, we are permitted to explore whether new treatment and care sought by the claimant is, in fact, causally related to claim. We have notified Mr. McDaniel of our intent to do so through depositions of the new doctors seen by Mr. Winfrey. That notice has spawned the instant set of motions before the court.

I would ask the court to simply re-deny the motion as was done previously because this is clearly an issue for the Commission—not the Court of Appeals. If I need to file any formal opposition or memorandum, please let me know.
