I am writing regarding the above transcript request. This office recently received a Rule 207 letter from the Court of Appeals indicating that the time period for receipt of the transcript had lapsed. Attached is the correspondence between this office and the Court of Appeals.

As you can see in the most recent letter from the Court of Appeals, they indicate that the Pfeiffer transcript *request* is not listed on your report(s). There appears there may be some overlap with the transcripts requested because the co-defendants both had separate hearings on the same day, July 9, 2014. 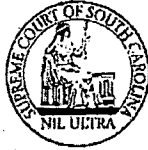


Dear Mr. Waters:

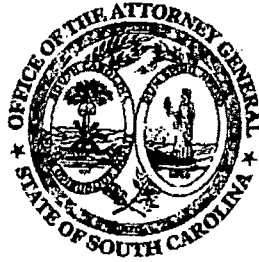
