

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Ralph Martin with this court on February 3, 2016. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Maurice C. Kinard v. State with the Supreme Court on February 1, 2016. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Joshua James Parker with this court on January 29, 2016. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Sammy Cowan v. State with the Supreme Court on January 21, 2016. 
4. As indicated by the consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.
