

## ORDER

Appellant has filed a copy of his inmate trust fund account report, which we construe as a motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*. The motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is denied pursuant to *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). The filing fee must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order.

Appellant has also filed a "notice and motion for request of transcript." Appellant, however, has failed to provide proof that he has ordered the transcript from the court reporter as required by Rule 207 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. Within fifteen days of this order, Appellant shall provide proof that he has made satisfactory arrangements in writing with the court reporter for furnishing the transcript.
