
ORDER

Respondents/Appellants have filed a motion to dismiss Appellants/Respondents appeal due to Appellants/Respondents failure to provide transcripts of various proceedings. Appellants/Respondents filed a return, explaining that they have received two of the three hearing transcripts, and they have attempted to procure the third transcript, stemming from the January 24, 2007 hearing, from the court reporter.

Because Appellants/Respondents have provided this Court with proof they complied with Rule 207 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules by ordering the transcripts and by requesting updates regarding the status from the court

reporter, who is apparently affiliated with Ray Swartz & Associates,
Respondents/Appellants motion to dismiss is denied.

Within twenty days, the court reporter shall deliver the transcript of the January 24,
2012 hearing to Appellants/Respondents or explain to the parties and this Court in
writing why the court reporter is unable to comply with this order.
Appellants/Respondents shall serve the court reporter with a copy of this order
upon receipt.
