## ORDER

This appeal was dismissed due to Appellant's failure to serve and file the record on appeal. Because Appellant has now served a record on appeal, the motion to reinstate is granted. However, because the record on appeal does not include all matter designated by the parties, Appellant must serve a supplemental record on appeal. Specifically, the supplemental record on appeal must include the transcript and the "errata sheet of the court reporter." Within ten days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve the supplemental record and file with this court the proof of service.

Respondent John E. White, Jr. filed a response noting his motion to dismiss "based upon the meritless nature of the appeal" had not been ruled upon. After consideration, the motion is denied. The merits of this appeal will be considered by a panel after final briefing.
