Aiding and Abetting Homicide By Child Abuse
§ 16-03-0085(A)(2), (B)

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on September 2015, the Grand Jurors of Lexington County present upon their oath:

That **Sara Elizabeth Hodson** did, willfully and unlawfully, in Lexington County, on or about December 8, 2012 through December 11, 2012, knowingly aid and abet another person, Jordan Ray Hodson, to commit child abuse or neglect, and the child abuse or neglect resulted in the death of a child under the age of eleven, to wit: MaKenna Hodson, date of birth October 1, 2012, the aforesaid infant died on December 11, 2012 as a result of child abuse or neglect, whether by act or omission, and such child abuse or neglect caused harm to the child's physical health or welfare, in violation of Section 16-3-85 (A)(2) and (B), S.C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.
