MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF

previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed petition for writ of certiorari and the accompanying appendix in the case of Christopher Clemons v. The State in this Court on February 17, 2016. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Daevon Williams with the Court of Appeals on February 9, 2016. 5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.




