
1. The brief of respondent in this case are due to be filed with the Court today. This is the third extension for Mr. Marshall.

Timothy Cobb on August 15, 2012. Counsel filed initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. Breyon Toney on August 8, 2012. On August 6, 2012, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in State v. Mike Salley and the briefs of petitioner in Gregory McHam v. State and Timothy Wallace v. State.


5. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purposes of delay.


