On March 10, 2016, the State sent this Court a letter outlining Appellant's continued refusal to comply with this Court's Order requiring Appellant to file a Record on Appeal that includes all matter designated by both Appellant and Respondent.

On March 29, 2016, the State received another "Record on Appeal" from Appellant that was filed with this Court on March 28, 2016. Aside from including several seemingly random page numbers in addition to the original matter in his previous two Records on Appeal, the "Record on Appeal" contains the same insufficiencies as the previous Records on Appeal Appellant has filed with this Court. Appellant's "Record on Appeal" also fails to correct the additional deficiencies noted by this Court in its deficiency letter dated March 9, 2016. Appellant's latest "Record on Appeal" is not in compliance with the Court's Order nor is it in compliance with Rule 210 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. The State would request this Court to grant the State's Motion to Dismiss and to dismiss the appeal for the aforementioned deficiencies and Appellant's continued refusals to comply with the orders of this Court.
