
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RECORD ON APPEAL AND INTITIAL
BRIEF

The Appellant, through its undersigned counsel, respectfully requests a 30-day extension to file the initial appellate documents in the above-referenced appeal.

Counsel has previously requested an extension in this matter based on the length of the record. This matter involves a multi-day trial, which resulted in a very long transcript. In addition, there are a number of complex legal issues to review and research which has resulted in this matter taking a longer amount of time to prepare than usual.
