
Dear Mr. Fain

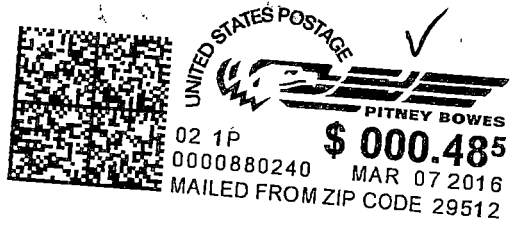

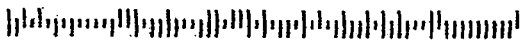
