

Dear Mr. Praduski,

I have received your inquiry concerning the Transcript of Record in the above-referenced matter that was forwarded to me by Court Administration.

Such transcripts cost \$3.25 per page. I estimate your transcript to be approximately 20 pages, for a total cost of \$65. Upon receipt of a total of \$65, (money order or cashier's check) I will be glad to place your transcript in line to be produced.

I see from your address that you are an inmate in the Department of Corrections. Please note that court reporters are not required by State or Federal law to provide free transcripts. It is also my understanding that no State agency is required to provide free transcripts, so I am unable to refer you to any other source.

I am given 60 days in which to prepare the record. Extensions of time may be granted, if necessary. My 60 days will not commence until receipt of your payment.
