

ORDER

This appeal was dismissed on September 3, 2015 due to Appellant's failure to provide the notice of appeal filing fee or proof of service for a motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*. This court did not receive a timely petition for rehearing and sent the remittitur down on September 24, 2015. Appellant has now filed a motion requesting that this court recall the remittitur and reinstate the appeal. A remittitur cannot be recalled except upon "a very strong showing . . . that remittitur was sent down through some mistake or inadvertence on the part of this [c]ourt or its officer." *State v. Keels*, 39 S.C. 553, 17 S.E. 802 (1893). Appellant has failed to make such a showing. The remittitur was properly sent, and this court no longer has jurisdiction over the case. Appellant's motion, therefore, is denied.
