
1. I, George Cleveland, III, swear under the penalty of perjury the following is true to the best of my knowledge;
2. My Assigned Dorm: TAWCAN A-side at Turbeville Correctional Institution was locked-down on March 19-21, 2016.
3. My cell-Room: 118 in TAW CAN A-side was without light from March 19-22, 2016. On March 20, 2016, ~~at~~ or around 12:30 p.m., I started requesting to duty-officer Sgt. Tollinson to call to the prison's operations office to request permission for me to use the dayroom in my dorm which had light from shift captain Pack, so I could finish up my petition for my P.C.R.-Appeal in this court (deadline. 3/21/16) at least three (3) times when he walked around to the cell-rooms for well-checks, around 5:00 p.m., he stated that

he had called operations, and there was
no answer, as well as attempts over the
radio. It was cloudy on March 19-20, 2016.
