Additional Information for the Clerk : This matter came before the Court on July 14, 2015 as a motion filed by the Plaintiff to compel the Defendant to resolve the fee dispute through the Resolution of Fee Dispute Board of the South Carolina Bar. In the fee agreement signed by Defendant, the agreement directly states that "any dispute concerning the fee due pursuant to this agreement shall be submitted by the dissatisfied party for a full, final resolution to the Resolution Fee Dispute Board of the South Carolina Bar, pursuant to Rule 416 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules." Because the Defendant disputes the fee for numerous alleged reasons, this Court finds that it is proper to take these matters up with the Resolution Fee Dispute Board pursuant to the signed contract. The other counterclaims and potential legal malpractice claim may remain under the Circuit Court jurisdiction. The Plaintiff's motion to compel resolution through the Fee Dispute Board is granted.
