
ORDER

This case was remitted on October 21, 2015. Respondent has filed a motion for costs pursuant to Rule 222, SCACR, seeking \$107.70 for the cost of printing the final brief, \$37.50 for the cost of the court reporter's transcript, \$1,000 in attorney's fees, and \$12.35 for the cost of postage to file the final brief.

Respondent's motion is granted in the amount of \$1,145.20 against Appellants. *See* Rule 222(a), SCACR ("[C]osts shall be taxed against the appellant when . . . judgment on appeal is affirmed."); Rule 222(b), SCACR (specifically permitting recovery for the cost of the transcript, the cost of printing the final brief, and \$1,000 in attorney's fees, and providing that any costs other than those specifically enumerated "will generally not be allowed except in the most extraordinary of circumstances").




