ORDER

On February 11, 2016, this court ordered Appellant to serve an amended record on appeal within twenty days that includes all matters designated by both Appellant and Respondent. Respondent has now filed a motion to dismiss, arguing that Appellant has failed to comply with our February 11, 2016 order.

Although Appellant has served and filed an amended record on appeal, the amended record does not include Respondent's designations of matter, and it is not consecutively paginated. Within ten days of this order, Appellant shall serve and file a second amended record on appeal that includes all of the documents referenced in Respondent's designation of matter filed on October 2, 2015, and contains page numbers on the bottom of each page beginning with the index. This court will consider the motion to dismiss upon receipt of the amended record on appeal or upon the expiration of ten days.
