1. The Appellant has prepared and is filing his multiple copies of his Record on Appeal which he believes to be due on March 28, 2016. This Record on Appeal contains the evidence of record as requested by both the Appellant and Respondent in this case.
2. A tape such as is described on the Respondent's Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal is in the possession of the Clerk of the South Carolina Workers' Compensation.
