


ORDER

This case was remitted on March 2, 2016. Respondent has now filed a motion for costs pursuant to Rule 222, SCACR, seeking payment for attorney's fees and expenses in the amount of \$1,117.61. Specifically, Respondent seeks reimbursement for \$1,000 in attorney's fees and \$117.61 for the cost of copying the final brief.

Respondent's motion is granted in the full amount of \$1,117.61. *See* Rule 222(b), SCACR (setting attorney's fees at \$1,000, specifically permitting a party to recover the cost of the transcript and printing a party's final brief, and stating that any costs other than those specifically enumerated "will generally not be allowed except in the most extraordinary of circumstances").
