

Our firm represents the Respondent in the above appeal. I am writing in response to Ms. Schneider's letter to you of March 28, 2016, enclosing a Motion for Extension of Time to File Initial Brief and Designation of Matter for Record on Appeal, copy enclosed.

The Notice of Appeal was served and filed on February 16, 2016. At that time the parties were in possession of the transcripts for the entire trial. In the Motion, Appellants state that the deadline for their initial briefs and designation of matter was April 8, 2016. That is incorrect.

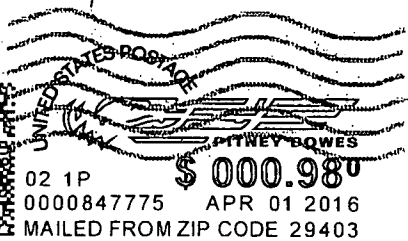
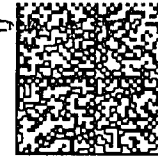
