Dear Counsel:

Upon reviewing your second joint motion for extension, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected in their entirety within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your motion may not be considered:

- The filing fee amount submitted is incorrect. Because counsel will be filing two separate initial reply briefs, two separate filing fees must be provided. The correct filing fee is \$50.00. We are returning your check (no. 45818) to you because the Court cannot accept a check that is more than thirty days old. The check you provided is dated February 29, 2016.
- Because this is your second request for extension, the Court must allow opposing counsel ten days to file a return to the motion. If you would like the Court to act on the motion immediately, you must provide written confirmation of opposing counsel's consent to the motion.
