
Dear Mr. Marvel:

I hereby acknowledge receipt of your request for transcript dated April 4, 2016 in the above-captioned case held in front of Judge Nicholson on October 19, 2015. I have reviewed my records and estimate that your transcript will be 50 pages. Based on the current rate of \$3.25 per page, the cost will be \$162.50, which includes postage. Under our rules, I have 60 days in which to complete the transcript.

Upon receipt of a certified check or money order (no personal checks, please, but a law firm check is acceptable), for \$162.50, the 60 days will begin. If I have underestimated the number of pages, you will be notified prior to delivery of the transcript of the balance due. 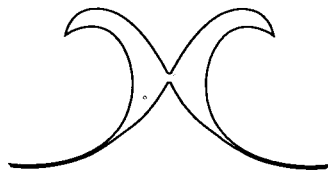

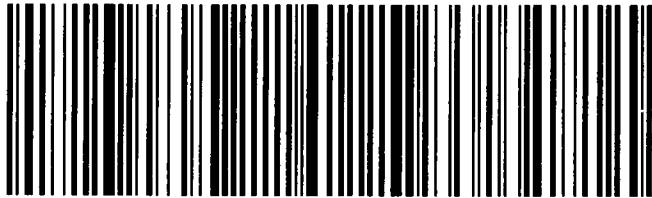
