injustice and will see our same case.

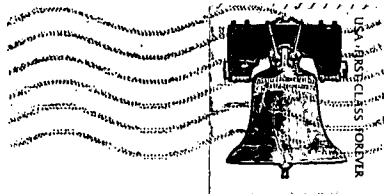
