MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Bobby Russell respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Mr. Russell respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.
3. On September 20, 2012, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Laquan Marshall v. State in the Supreme Court. On September 19, 2012, counsel filed a Motion to Remand to Lower Court in Jimmy Ott Cuttino v. State in this Court. On September 18, 2012, counsel held an oral argument in State v. James J.
