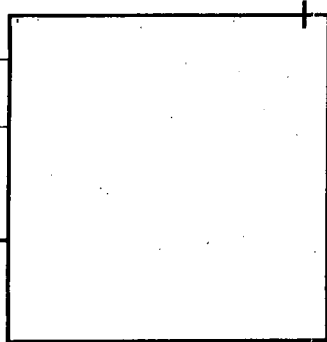

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: 63-05-0070 / UNLAWFUL CONDUCT TOWARDS A CHILD

I further state that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime set forth and that probable cause is based on the following facts:

ON 01/12/2016 AT 0820HR, ONE LONNIE PADGETT DID KNOWINGLY AND WILLINGLY VIOLATE SECTION 63-05-0070 OF THE SC CODE OF LAWS IN THAT HE DID PICK UP HIS 3-YEAR OLD CHILD THAT HE IS THE PARENT OF AND RESPONSIBLE FOR THE WELFARE OF FROM KIDS HOUSE DAY CARE LOCATED AT 1073 EUTAW ST IN THE CITY OF ORANGEBURG, SC AND PLACED THE CHILD IN THE FRONT SEAT OF THE VEHICLE WITHOUT A CHILD SEAT AND DROVE TO WALMART WITH THE CHILD. THE DEFENDANT WAS APPARENTLY UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF SOME TYPE OF DRUGS IN THAT HIS MOTOR FUNCTION SKILLS WERE APPARENTLY IMPAIRED. DEFENDANTS CONDITION WAS WITNESSED ON SCENE BY SEVERAL OFFICERS. DEFENDANT'S ACTIONS PLACED THE CHILD AT UNREASONABLE RISK OF HARM AFFECTING THE CHILD'S PHYSICAL SAFETY. 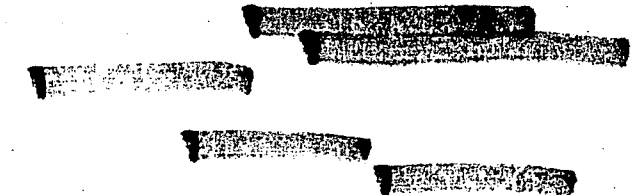
