## ORDER

Respondent's motion to compel is granted to the extent that Appellant shall consecutively number the bottom of each page of the record on appeal. Within twenty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall (1) serve Respondent with a copy of the record on appeal that has a page number on the bottom of each page with the page numbers starting with the index and going through to the last page; and (2) either come in to the court to place these page numbers on the previously filed copies of the record or serve and file amended copies that contain the proper pagination. Respondent's final brief shall be served and filed within twenty days after receiving the properly paginated record on appeal.
