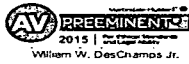

Dear Mr. Shearouse:

I represent the Appellant, Rosemary Jenrette, whose petition for rehearing was denied April 22, 2016 by the South Carolina Court of Appeals, a copy of which is enclosed herewith. Our position is that the decision of the Court of Appeals is in conflict with prior decisions of the Supreme Court which may well be the result of novel issues of fact and, perhaps, novel questions of law being presented. Consequently, we are of the opinion that a petition for a writ of certiorari is proper in this instance. The service and filing of said writ and the accompanying appendix would be due on May 22, 2016.

The purpose of this letter and enclosed motion is to respectfully request a twenty (20) day extension of time to file and serve the petition for the writ of certiorari and the accompanying appendix making same due on or before June 11, 2016. The primary reason the request is being made is that my wife and office manager, Peggy DesChamps, is scheduled to continue with her chemotherapy treatments through June 7, 2016. At that time, hopefully, her oncology treatments will be in the form of antigens which should allow me more time to devote to my practice.
