MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Dennis M. Penny, II with the Court of Appeals on March 3, 2016. Counsel filed the initial reply brief of appellant in the case of State v. Travis Polite with the Court of Appeals on March 2, 2016.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.


