PAGE LIMIT FOR A PETITION FOR

The undersigned counsel would respectfully request an order allowing her to file a petition for writ of certiorari in this case in excess of the twenty-five page limit imposed by Rule 243(e)(3), SCACR. In support of this motion, counsel would respectfully show the Court:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and the appendix in this case are due to be filed on May 4, 2016.
2. Counsel submits that the petition for writ of certiorari includes four separate issues. In order to properly address the legal arguments in support of the four separate issues, counsel


submits that the petition for writ of certiorari must exceed by one page the twenty-five pages authorized by Rule 243(e)(3), SCACR.


