On February 22, 2016, the State filed a Motion to Strike and Compel Filing of Complete Record on Appeal. On March 15, 2016, the State received Appellant's "Response to Respondent's Motion to Strike/Dismiss." The State is sending this letter in reply to Appellant's "Response to Respondent's Motion to Strike/Dismiss." Appellant's response is simply an assertion that he inadvertently failed to include Judge Hyman's Order dated 8/12/14.<sup>1</sup> Respondent then attached two stapled copies of Judge Hyman's Order. Despite Appellant's inclusion of Judge Hyman's Order, Appellant's Record on Appeal is still not in compliance with the requirements of Rule 210 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. The State requests this Court order Appellant to file a record on appeal that fully complies with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. In the event of continued noncompliance by Appellant, the State requests that this Court dismiss this appeal with prejudice.
