ORDER

Respondent has filed a motion to limit Appellant's brief, which we construe as a motion to strike Appellant's initial brief. After review of Appellant's initial brief, the motion is granted because the brief does not comply with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.

Within thirty days of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended initial brief, which complies with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. Specifically, Appellant's brief shall contain the following: a table of contents and cases; a statement of issues on appeal; a statement of the case; an argument section; and a conclusion. *See* Rule 208(b)(1), SCACR. A sample Appellant's brief is included in Appendix C, Form 13 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. Appellant is further reminded that the brief "shall contain references to the transcript, pleadings, order exhibits, or other materials which may be properly included in the Record on Appeal [see Rule 210(c)] to support the salient facts alleged." *See* Rule 208(b)(4), SCACR. Finally, the brief shall contain page numbers, and the caption shall appear as described in Rule 267(a), of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
