


Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I appreciate the Court's consideration in this matter, and by copy of this letter I am notifying Counsel for the Respondents of this request for the extension.

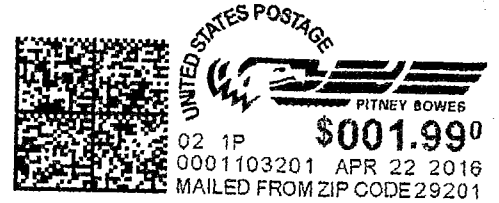
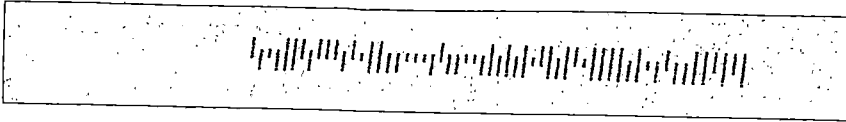
