This letter concerns the two extension requests pending in this case. I have never opposed an extension request. I consent to both motions.

That said, the supersedeas petition is facially deficient and should be immediately dismissed, without prejudice. My client was not the moving party; thus, my client will not be afforded the opportunity to respond if the moving party supplies the required information in its reply. There is no sur-reply in the appellate court rules.

As to the appellant's requested extension, I would note that the appellant is not the party who requested a supersedeas. The appellant's deadline to file a return was the same as my client's deadline—April 28—and Appellant lacks standing to argue someone else's motion.
