

## ORDER

This appeal was dismissed due to Appellant's failure to serve and file his initial brief and designation of matter.<sup>1</sup> Appellant has now filed a motion for an extension of time to serve and file his initial brief and designation of matter, which we construe as a petition to rehear the dismissal of his appeal. After careful consideration of the petition for rehearing, the Court is unable to discover that any material fact or principle of law has been either overlooked or disregarded, and hence, there is no basis for granting a rehearing or reinstating this appeal. Accordingly, the petition for rehearing is denied.

After granting Appellant three extensions, this court ordered Appellant on February 8, 2016, to serve and file his initial brief and designation of matter within ten days and explained that failure to comply with the order would result in the dismissal of the appeal. Appellant failed to comply with the order, and this appeal was dismissed on March 1, 2016.
