
Dear Mr. McDaniels:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or the appeal will be dismissed:

- An amended notice of appeal must be served and filed. Please review Rule 203, and Form 1 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR, for the correct format. The amended notice of appeal must include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken. Specifically, the correspondence included with your circuit court order is titled "Rule 59/ Writ of Certorari."
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$100.00.

- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The order you are appealing features an abbreviated caption. You must provide a copy of an order issued in this matter which includes the complete case caption.
