

ORDER

On April 15, 2016, this Court denied Appellant's petition for rehearing from the denial of Appellant's motion to stay and granted Attorney Eleazer R. Carter's motion to be relieved as counsel for Appellant. Haiyan Lin has now filed several motions, including a motion to vacate the order relieving counsel because she wants to file a response on behalf of Petrel International, LLC. After consideration of Haiyan Lin's objections to the motion to relieve counsel, this Court adheres to the order relieving Mr. Carter as counsel for Appellant. Furthermore, because Haiyan Lin has not paid a filing fee for her motions and cannot represent Appellant pro se pursuant to *Renaissance Enterprises, Inc. v. Appellant must retain new counsel and new counsel shall make an appearance as counsel of record for Appellant within thirty days of the date of this order, or this appeal will be dismissed.
