Upon reviewing your notice of appeal and proof of service, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR, including the name of the attorney of record - not only the name of the firm.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, our records suggest that Benjamin B. Davis, Esquire, is the attorney of record for the respondent, Knology of Charleston, Inc.


