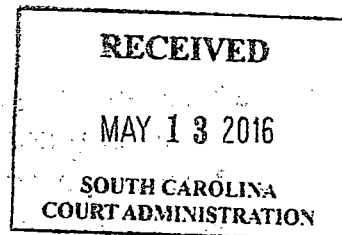
I would request a corrected transcript immediately and wish that you would instruct your court reporter to cease and desist this brand of theft.

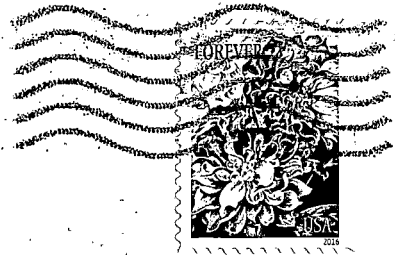
