Dear Ms. Jennings and Mr. Brandt:

I received a letter from Ms. Jennings dated June 22, 2012, indicating that Ms. Jennings is now back in the Greenville area and would be available at a mutually agreeable time to attempt to reconstruct the record in the above captioned matter.

I have the following schedule for July: I am in Anderson for General Sessions for the term of July 16<sup>th</sup> and in Oconee for the term of July 23<sup>rd</sup>. We could attempt to schedule a hearing to reconstruct the record the latter part of that week or during my chambers week, beginning September 24<sup>th</sup>. Otherwise, it may be that we may have to meet on a Saturday if our schedules cannot be reconciled. I request that upon your receipt of this letter each of you contact my office to let me know when you can be available.


