

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

Dear Mr. Heyward:

In order that I might add some additional clarification to my 8/14/2012 letter to you, there were no "corrections" to the original transcript as far as making any changes to the verbatim words that were first transcribed. Instead, my oversight was in transcribing only one of the two motions heard in your case that day or in not transcribing the second motion versus the first motion heard.

After your 5/24/12 letter, your secretary and I discussed concerns that you were in attendance but your name was not on the appearance sheet. I checked my notes and audio for what I had transcribed and relayed to her my records showed you were not in attendance and to let me know if there were other specifics that were being questioned. Looking back, I now understand why you were confused. After your second letter August 9, 2012 I pulled my records and realized we had later gone back on the record for a second motion and you did appear for that motion.
