Will you be so kind to Forward a stamp, clock, copy of the September 6, 2012, for my record. Petitioner asks this court to review the record (exhibit's).

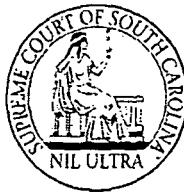
