I am writing you about the above captioned case. As attorneys for the above named Carlton and Janet Woodard Revocable Trust, who is the Respondent in this case, I reflect that we received a Notice of Intent to Appeal from Tommy Middleton through his attorney, William Koatesworth Swope, with a Certificate of Mailing dated June 25, 2012.
